

## **Winter Weather Cancellation Policy**

### **Sunday Mornings:**

In the event of inclement winter weather, a decision about cancelling Sunday morning services/activities will be made no later than 7:00 am that morning. If conditions or weather forecast warrants, a decision may be made Saturday night at 9:00 pm. In some cases, we will postpone services and hold one combined service at 10:00am with Sunday School following service. All services will automatically be cancelled when Hancock County is under a Level 3 snow emergency. Information regarding service changes will be available in the following ways:

2. E-mail alert to be sent to all members signed up for the weekly bulletin email

### **Connection Groups/Scheduled Meetings/Events:**

If weather concerns develop during the day a decision will be made by 4:00pm or two hours prior to the event, whichever is earlier, by the group leader or staff member in charge.

### **Severe Thunderstorm/Tornado Warnings:**

In the event a Severe Thunderstorm or Tornado Warning is issued in Hancock County before the start of any scheduled church activity, the activity will be cancelled. If a warning is issued during an activity, people must take shelter in a designated safety area immediately.
